Opportunities to participate in education and service and to support those who do

Our Goal

It is the intent of the Bethel College Mennonite Church to support its members and particularly its young adults in both service programs and in higher education, each of which enriches their lives and contributes to the mission of the congregation and the welfare of society.

There are opportunities for those called to service or study as well as those able to provide financial assistance.

Service

Various Mennonite agencies (e.g. Mennonite Church USA, the Mennonite Central Committee,) provide opportunities for persons to contribute a significant portion of their lives in many programs of voluntary service. Sometimes this occurs in a year between high school and college or it can occur during or after college graduation. We want to support our young adults for such service (either a calendar year or equal to the academic year) in proportion

to what we support for undergraduate education for Bethel College.

Service scholarships are provided through the BCMC Mission and Service Endowment Fund supported by contributions, memorial gifts, and bequests.

Education

As a college-related church it is the intent of the Bethel College Mennonite Church to support financially, spiritually, and intellectually the pursuit of undergraduate and seminary study at Mennonite related institutions.

BCMC provides \$500 per semester to members of the BCMC community enrolled fulltime at an accredited college or university of an Anabaptist denomination.

Because of our special relationship with Bethel College, BCMC provides \$1000 per semester to members attending Bethel College.

BCMC budgets \$500 per semester for each student attending an Anabaptist institution. Members support this by giving to the annual budget.

An additional \$500 per semester is raised by above-budget contributions designated to the <u>BCMC Bethel College Scholarship Fund.</u>
